## WELCOME!

The global perspective is dramatic when one looks at anticipated offshore wind development: today there is 20GW installed globally and it has taken 25 years to get here. One anticipates a further 100 to 120 GW by 2030 – a more than 10-fold increase in growth rate.

Looking at the UK, clean, green offshore wind is set to power more than 30% of British electricity by 2030 announced Claire Perry, Energy and Clean Growth Minister, with the launch of the new joint government-industry **Offshore Wind Sector Deal** in March. The Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy (BEIS) is suggesting that UK alone should be able to produce 100GW by 2050.
