INTSOK delegation 23-28 March 2014

Sunday 23 March (Pemba)

Johannesburg - Pemba : 11.30 (arrival in Pemba 14.20). Also possible to arrive via Dar or Nairobi.

Check in Pemba Beach Hotel. Informal gathering/briefing on program etc. Embassy will arrange transport.

Monday 24 March (Pemba)

0900: Introductory meeting. Safety brief.

09.30: Briefing by Nunu Sidiono (Energy Works/CTA CTA - Association for Moz businesses) on local content and business climate (tbc)

10.30: Excursion to port. Meeting with *Portos de Cabo Delgado* (subsidiary of ENH-logistics), the Port Authorities, and Provincial Director of the Mineral Resource Ministry, MIREM (tbc)

13.00: Lunch with relevant stakeholders (tbc)

14.00: Meeting with ENI and Anadarko (tbc)

19.00: Dinner hosted by the Norwegian Ambassador (at Hotel)

Tuesday 25 March (Pemba/Maputo)
