Bilateral initiative project within EEA Financial Mechanism and Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014-2021 Bilateral Fund.

The workshop is first phase in a project with objective to establish a robust bilateral network between Norwegian and Polish entities and promote long-term cooperation in carbon capture and storage (CCS) technologies. There will be one workshop in Poland for mapping Polish capabilities in parallel with this session in Norway mapping the Norwegian skills and ambitions. The project will follow up with a Polish delegation to Norway meeting Norwegian companies, seminar/B2B meetings in Poland and a CCS summer school for students.

The project is a collaboration between Norwegian Energy Partners (NORWEP), the University of Oslo (UiO) and AGH University of Krakow.

The main objective with the workshop is to understand the Polish market and the opportunities, what Norwegian industry can offer and how Poland and Norway can do business together in the CCS sector.

Workshop targets:

- Arrange a meeting for Norwegian CCUS companies, organisations and academia
- Map what Norwegian companies could offer to Poland
- Map the potential for cooperation with Polish companies (project, technologies, research etc.)
- Coordinate cooperation with Polish companies/research centre
